<h1>April 2005</h1>				Parting of the Red Sea, 1462 BC Moses parted the Red Sea on Tue 14 Apr 1462 BC on a day 1 Wind (SR) and 1 Birth (Venus). That combination of days occurs once every 32 years, an in April once every 384 years. This year that happens on 23 April, so it is a great time to celebrate it. The original Parting also happened on the Last Day of Passover (21 Nisan) and 1 Creation (M).		
				Resurrection of Jesus Christ: Sun 3 Apr AD 33. Easter tends to be on the Sunday after Passover, but this year the traditional Hebrew calendar has Passover very late, on 24 Apr. The Christian Easter falls on 27 Mar, but this is one of the few years when my calculations differ with the usual formula. Easter should be celebrated on Easter of the Perpetual Hebrew Calendar (PH), which falls on 3 Apr this year, the same as it did at the Resurrection of Jesus.		Elaine Cannon, b. 9 Apr 1922 Young Women's President (1978-1984). Her birthday this year ties with 8 Oct for the <i>Holiest Day of the Year</i> . It is a holy day on six calendars: End Tending (J), End Passover(E), Firstfruits (P), 0 Resurrection (M), Winter Fast (EF) and 13 Rabbit (SR).
